

## **Current International Lines**

#### SINET5 has direct international lines to Europe, USA, and Asia.


- Europe: Two 10-Gbps lines to London for small latency via Russia
- USA: 100-Gbps line to Los Angeles, 10-Gbps line to New York, and 10-Gbps backup line
- Asia: 10-Gbps line to Singapore





## JP-SG cable cut

- SINET JP-SG 10G link was affected during 8<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2017 11<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2017 (about 33days 8hours)
- Rerouted via JP-HK-SG
  - JP-HK was supported by JGN new 100G link (mutual cooperation)
  - HK-SG was supported by Asi@Connect 10G link
    - JGN HK-SG was working for upgrading to 100G





## **Upgrade Plan in 2019**

- SINET will upgrade the Europe-Japan line to 100 Gbps (to Amsterdam)
- SINET will also have a 100-Gbps line from Tokyo to New York via Los Angeles
  - Direct 10-Gbps Tokyo-New York line will be terminated
- SINET will probably have a 100-Gbps line between Amsterdam and New York
- SINET will have a 100-Gbps Tokyo-Singapore line (upgrade from 10 Gbps)
- The Europe-Japan line will be operational in February 2019 and the other lines in March 2019.
