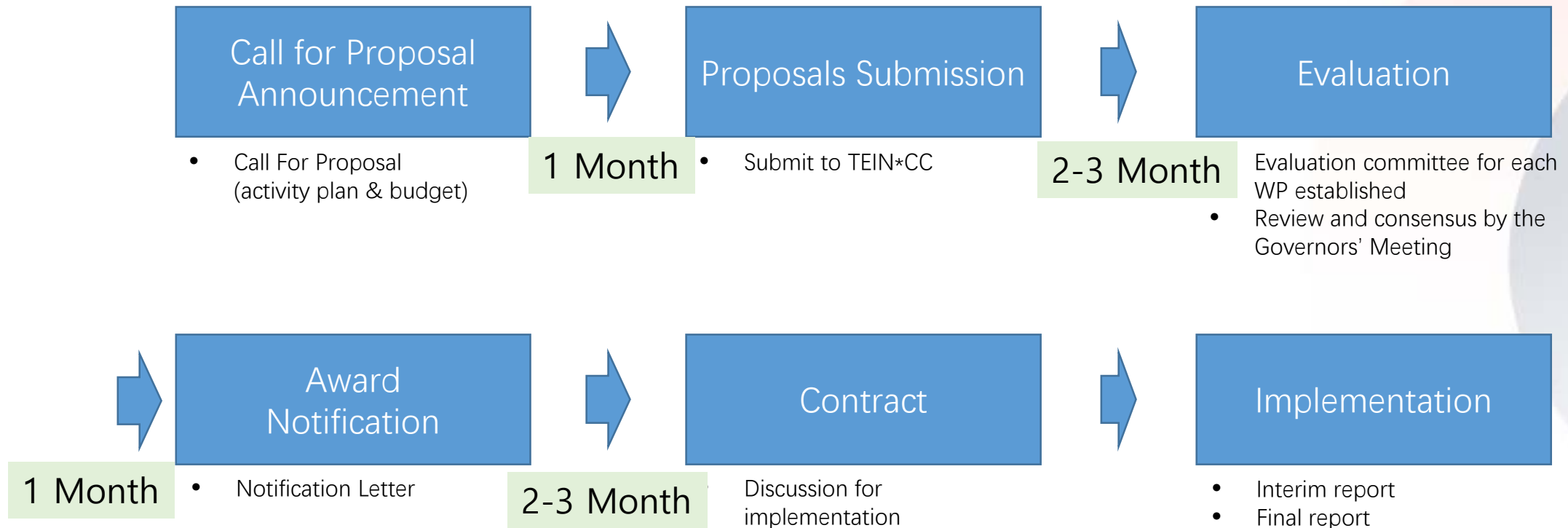
Overview of Asi@Connect Call

This will be done by establishing an industry-initiated open and neutral Internet exchange point, interconnection with PHOpenIX, intensive training, advocating best practices and standards such as IPv6, and harnessing new technologies such as software defined networking.
