- Extend eduroam coverage into countries with limited or no existing coverage

- Following the success of the first TEIN eduroam project
- Second TEIN eduroam project established January 2018
- Call for participants issued
- Eight responses received
- All accepted as project participants
- Each participating country nominated 3 institutions to setup eduroam
- The project will supply training and hardware to enable basic eduroam setup in each country


